We are a group of individuals and congregations, young people and adults, who covenant together each summer to create a community based on inclusion, hospitality, and hope for all participants to grow in their identity as beloved people of God.

In striving to make beloved community possible, we covenant to:

- Care for the creation around us
- Treat others with decency and respect
- Participate in all scheduled activities, and abide by curfew and lights-out schedule

Because it is detrimental to the BYC community, we covenant to refrain from:

- Gambling
- Sexual activity
- Entering sleeping cabins other than your own
- The use of individual, portable electronic entertainment and gaming devices and headphones, except inside one's own cabin
- The use of cell phones

Out of respect for this community, we covenant to reject:

- The use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, knives, or firearms.
- Violence
- Intentional destruction of property and the environment

We understand that breaking this Covenant affects the trust that helps make Baptist Youth Camp possible. We recognize that if we choose to break this Covenant, there will be consequences as deemed appropriate by adult and congregational leadership. We understand that violations may result in our being separated from Baptist Youth Camp, and returned home at our family's expense and arrangement. We commit to hold one another accountable in this Covenant.
